Creating Sheep Nations: Using the Israel Template

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Introduction

There is a very peculiar prophetic statement of Jesus found in Math. 25:32-33. Jesus said that He will gather the nations before Him and separate the sheep nations from the goat nations. Prophecy writers don't really know where to place this in a prophetic timeline.

I want to share with you the following:

There is no nation on earth that is a sheep nation (that includes modern Israel). What constitutes a "sheep nation"?

God gave us the Israel template in the Old Testament on how to create a sheep nation. And here is a very controversial fact I will prove to you...most of the Israelites leaving Egypt used to be Egyptians! Through the evangelistic work of Abraham and Joseph and the teaching ministry of Moses.

With the great world revival now happening it is time prophetically to create God's people into new nations for the great work that needs to be done. And it is not by politics or political parties!

Let me give you the scriptural background to what I believe Jesus was referring to in these verses:

"And before him shall be gathered all the nations and he shall separate them one from another as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats." (Math 25:32)

The question is: What did Jesus have in mind when He talked about sheep and goat nations? We need to answer this before considering when does this happen on God's prophetic timeline.

God Forms the Nations

To answer this question we need to go back to when God first formed the nations of the world. This happened after the flood and after the Tower of Babel incident when God divided the nations by confusing their language. Scripture describes 70 nations being formed. Genesis 10:31

"These are the families of the sons of Noah after their generations in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood."

Moses however in Deuteronomy 32:7-9 gives us an important piece of information that I believe Jesus was referring to. It will to clarify the issue if I quote it for you out of the Septuagint version of the Bible which by the way was the scripture that Jesus read (and Paul). It says this:

"Remember the days of old consider the years of many generations: ask your father and he will show you and your elders and they will tell you (Moses was referring here to the Tower of Babel incident). When the Most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the nations according to the number of the angels of God. For the Lord's portion is his people; Jacob is the lot of his inheritance."

In you Bible which uses the Masoretic text which was compiled about 900 AD says he set the bounds of the nations according to "the number of the children of Israel."

This is wrong! This is not what Jesus was reading...this was an unwarranted change of text by Jewish Rabbi's 900 years after Christ.

This fact is important because it tells us something of the spiritual warfare that we are facing when translating people out of "goat nations" into God's "sheep nations" and why Satan could offer Jesus the nations of the world in the temptation in the wilderness.

Let's go deeper into scripture because there is profound truth to be found in those verses which explain a lot to do with prophecy, Israel, Abraham's seed and the Church as a "holy nation".

First remember the context of the Tower of Babel incident. God had sent destruction and judgment on the earth through the flood because the people did not want to serve Him. Then after the flood Nimrod gathers the people and sets up a rebellion again against the Lord with his Tower of Babel project.

This time the Lord said enough....you don't want to serve me, ok I give you other gods to serve. So He divided the people into 70 different nations and gave them over to new gods by allowing the fallen angels to rule over them.

We see this in the book of Daniel where the ruling fallen angel over Persia, called the Prince of Persia withstood Gabriel for 21 days until Michael the archangel came to assist in the battle. (Daniel 10:13)

We see this in Deut. 4:19 where the Moses says to Israel....

"And lest you lift up your eyes to heaven....and all the host of heaven (fallen angels) and be driven to worship them and serve them which the Lord your God has divided unto all the nations under the whole of heaven."

We see in Psalm 82 an amazing declaration.... "God stands in the congregation of the mighty, judges among th e How long will you judge unjustly and accept the persons of the wicked? Defend the poor and the fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy: rid them out of the hands of the wicked.....I have said You are gods and all of you children of the most High. But you shall die like men and fall oft h e princes. Arise O God, judge the earth for you shall inherit all nations."

This is incredible truth! Fallen angels whom the Lord calls gods who have been given rulership over the nations...The Lord accuses them of abuse, injustice, lack of compassion for the needy, oppression and vain glory desiring worship from the people instead of true worship of the Lord God.

He judges them and says they will be cast out of the heavens and will die like men losing their power and immortality.

And then the important prophetic statement to the Son of God:

You shall inherit all nations!

Now couple this wonderful prophecy in Psalm 2

"The Lord has said unto me, You are my Son this day have I begotten you. Ask of me and I will give you the heathen for your inheritance and the uttermost parts of the earth for your possession. You will break them with a rod of iron and shall dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel"

Satan offered Jesus His inheritance, the nations of the world, the easy way. Jesus refused. He had a better plan. His plan is to break the nations and peoples into pieces with a rod of iron and out of those broken nations...grow new nations...His sheep nations.

God's New Adopted Family vrs The 70 Nations of the World

Now back to Deuteronomy 32 and a very important clue as to how the Lord will inherit and create new nations. Moses said there the nations of the world were divided. 70 nations under the misrule of wicked gods who used to be glorious mighty sons of God. But they wanted their own kingdoms, they wanted to be like God, to be worshipped and obeyed.

They got whole nations to rule...God decided to start with a man and his family. Abraham and his descendants. And Moses especially points out the command to Abraham's grandson... Jacob was to be God's lot, His inheritance. This is what God told Jacob....

Gen: 35:9-11 "And God appeared to Jacob and blessed him...and God said unto him Your name is Jacob: your name shall not be called any more Jacob but Israel shall be your name and he called his name Israel. And God said to him, I am God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of you..."

Now note the plan of God here:

First a nation was to come from Jacob and then many nations.

The nation was Israel. And the "company of nations"? The Hebrew word here also means a "multitude" of nations!

Here is where the dispensationalists and Christian Zionists get all confused. They get caught up with the one nation: Israel. All prophecy centred around one nation. Everyone rejoicing to see "Israel" restored. But what ever happened to the many nations that God prophesied would come forth?

Now here is the idea I want to introduce to you:

God formed the nation of Israel with all their history and covenants and victories and trials and tribulations as a sort of template, a guide, an instruction manual as to how to form all the coming company of many nations to come.

Now while He was busy forming the Israel template He placed all the other peoples of the world under temporary rule by all sorts of other governments and placed times and territory restrictions on them.

But His ultimate plan was that all peoples would eventually come under His rule. This is clearly stated in Rev.7:9 "After this I beheld an lo a great multitude which no man could number of all nations and kindreds and people and tongues stood before the throne and before the Lamb clothed with white robes...."

Don't let anyone tell you only a handful are getting saved. In the generations to come you cannot count the multitudes of nations and peoples coming under His Kingdom rule!

But God is a wise builder. He does all things by

order, discipline. People need to be saved, discipled and brought into new covenant relationships using the Israel template as a guide. What do I mean?

Let me give you the growth order of how Israel was formed:

It starts with a man: Abraham

Then a family: Abraham, his wife Sarah and his son Isaac and grandson Jacob.

Then a clan: Jacob and his extended clan of 70 who enter Egypt.

Then the clan grows into tribes: The twelve sons of Jacob grow into 12 tribes.

Then the tribes come out of Egypt and claim a land for themselves and form a nation: Israel!

.Who Makes up the New Israel Nations?

But here is a very important fact for you to understand:

If you look closely at the Israel template on who made up the new nation of Israel, it was not physical biological descendants of Abraham or Jacob...this is where the Christian Zionists miss the whole idea of who Israel is. Most of those coming out of Egypt were Egyptian who became Hebrews by adopting the God of Abraham. And were eventually enslaved and abused by subsequent Pharaohs because of their supposed apostasy and refusal to believe in the many gods of Egypt!

Jacob and the new nation of Israel

Before Jacob and his clan arrived in Egypt the Lord had prepared the way for Jacob to turn Hebrews into Israelites, because Abraham and Joseph had already turned a multitude of Egyptians into Hebrews! How? They gave testimony to the whole nation from the Pharaoh down to the people that there is One God! Not a multitude of gods...first the Lord caused the incident with Abraham, Sarah and Pharaoh using the beauty of Sarah to get Abraham before Pharaoh, then Joseph saved the nation from starvation and became a national hero...and people turned from their gods to accept the God of Joseph and Abraham. They were called "Hebrews".

I know most commentators think the term "Hebrew" comes from one of Abraham's forefathers 'Eber"....but "heber" in Hebrew also means "to cross over"...those who crossed over from the gods of Egypt to Abraham's God....were 'Hebrews''!

When Jacob the clan father arrived with the brothers of Joseph, people joined the clan under the different tribal names. Ancient societies had this practice. When you became a Roman citizen you joined one of the many Roman clans and tribes in order to participate in voting for the tribunes and consuls.

Now I am going to give you some very important scriptural and historical information about the millions who came out of Egypt as Hebrews. Jacob and his clan of 70 went into Egypt....and 210 years later Moses came out with millions of "Hebrews"!

Here is the important point....the idea of 'Israel' has never been about a racial identity...that you are an Israelite because you are the offspring of Abraham. That is why it is important to understand that most of the people who came out of Egypt as "Hebrews" were in fact Egyptian converts...and that is how we today also make up new Israel nations!

How do you get Jacob and his extended family of 70 going to settle in Egypt (when they discover that Joseph is still alive and has become the Prime Minister under Pharaoh) and then years later out come about 3 million Israelites under Moses heading for the promised land.

Here is the problem: If you take the 12 sons of Jacob and their wives and you start assuming each had to have so many children, who in turn had so many children you just are not able mathematically to come to a figure of 3 million. That figure of 3 million Israelites is extrapolated from the census taken by Moses of about 600,000 men of fighting age. If you then add their wives and their children and the aged above fighting age you get to a good guess of 3 million plus!

Israelites were 210 Years in Egypt...Not 400 Years!

Every preacher assumes that the Israelites were in Egyptian bondage for 400 years. Paul's comment in Gal. 3:17 and the Lord's statement to Abraham in Genesis 15 7-21 seem to indicate that. Some of you might have seen some difficult extrapolations of how many children each women would have to bear over 400 years in order to get therefore to 3 million Israelites in the Exodus. Astronomically huge families!

Now let me make that calculation even more difficult with the following statement that can be proven from both scripture and other sources: The Israelite captivity in Egypt was actually just 210 years making it impossible to have 3 million actual genetic descendants of Jacob and his 12 sons coming out of Egypt. And that means that the far greatest majority of who we today called the Israelites under the leadership of Moses were actually Egyptians who were adopted by faith into the covenant of Abraham. Let me show you...

What is not very well known among preachers is that among rabbinic scholars and Talmudic commentaries the fact that Israel was only 210 years in Egypt is actually well known and accepted. This is supported not only by careful scriptural analysis but also by two historical documents:

Josephus the Jewish general of the 70 ad war against Rome and a contemporary of Paul in his "Antiquities of the Jews" (II,15,ii) had this to say...

"They left Egypt in the month of Xanthicus (also known to the Jews as Abib and Nissan) four hundred and thirty years after our forefather Abraham came into Canaan but only two hundred and fifteen years after Jacob removed into Egypt" (the dispute among scholars is whether it was 210 or 215 years, not if it was 400 years!)

The ancient book of Jasher which is mentioned in Joshua 10:13 and again in 2 Sam. 1:18 was lost for many years and was rediscovered in 1613 and translated into English in 1840 has this to say (Jasher 81:3-4):

"And the sojourning of the children of Israel who dwelt in the land of Egypt in hard labour was two hundred and ten years. And at the end

of two hundred and ten years the Lord brought forth the children of Israel with a strong hand."

Let me help clarify the scriptures surrounding this very important truth with a timeline from Adam at year 0 and then using the Bible's own chronology of years we come up with the following times: To put it on our times the Exodus was in 1446 BC and you can work the rest from there if you want. But lets explain the scriptures from these times.

Adam.....year 0
Abraham Covenantyear 2018 (after Adam)
Isaac bornyear 2048
Jacob enters Egyptyear 2238
Exodusyear 2448

The first important date is that Abram was 70 years old when we encounter his first covenant made with the Lord in Genesis 15. There are two important date statements that the Lord makes here: Genesis 15:13:

"Know for certainty that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs where they will be enslaved and oppressed four hundred years."

The fact of Abram's descendants being strangers and oppressed in a land that is not theirs started with Isaac (who was oppressed by both older brother Ishmael as well as the residents of Canaan) as we can see from the above dates and carried on for 400 years until their Exodus out of Egypt.

But then the Lord makes a very interesting comment about their time of actual captivity in the same section in verse 16:

"Then in the fourth generation they shall return here (i.e. Canaan) for the iniquity of the Amorite is not yet complete."

Important note: 4 generations is not 400 years! This promise of the Lord to Abraham that his descendants would be four generations in Egypt is supported by Numbers 26:59 that shows the genealogy of Moses making his great grandfather to have been Levi the son of Jacob. Jacob and sons go into Egypt and Levi's greatgrandson Moses, the fourth generation, comes out with 3 million Hebrews. From 70 to 3 million in 4 generations? How?

Then we have the interesting statement of Paul in Gal.3:17 that from the covenant made with Abraham to the law given to Moses was 430 years:

"And this I say that the covenant that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after cannot be annulled that it should make the promise of none effect."

As you can see from the timeline above the 430 years Paul mentions is correct from the first covenant made with Abram in Genesis 15 until the Exodus and Mount Sinai giving of the law. This 430 year timeline that Paul gives in Galatians makes no room for Israelites being in Egypt for 400 years.

These facts make real problems for Christian Zionists. So they go into denial. They do not discuss it and they do not mention it. It is absolutely critical to their theology of Dual Covanentalism that God has an enduring covenant with the literal, genetic offspring of Abraham and through Isaac and Jacob. It's impossible such racial purity can be 3000 years later extended to the modern day Israel.

But now I have presented you the facts of the Exodus from Egypt which is this:

If you believe in the literal truth of the Bible that about 3 million Israelites left Egypt with Moses then all you have is 210 (or 215) years to go from 70 coming with Jacob into Egypt to 3 million literal genetic descendants of Jacob leaving Egypt....and that is impossible even if you still want to hold to 400 years in Egypt.

Now here is the unpalatable truth that Christian Zionists do not want to accept but which is wonderful news for the Kingdom of God:

The vast majority of the children of Israel leaving Egypt with Moses were Egyptians!

So how did they become Israelites? The same way all other peoples of all races at all times have been grafted into the Israel family: By adoption through faith in the God of Abraham who is Jesus Christ our risen Lord. And praise God, He is still today turning Egyptians into Israelites! Some one please tell our Coptic brethren in Egypt this piece of interesting news...it could revolutionize Egyptian and Israeli relationships!

The Mystery of the Hebrews

Let me explain this process of turning Egyptians into Israelites a bit further. It goes like this.

Abram goes into Egypt with his wife Sarah. Sarah is a stunning beauty (would love to meet her in heaven one day!). Abram is scared if Pharaoh gets to hear of her beauty then he will take her. This seemed to happen often with Abram and Sarah but for a reason. King Abimelech in Canaan tried the same thing. And God appeared to him and told him make ready to die, I am going to kill you. Why oh God cries Abimelech. Because you have taken the wife of my servant Abram. Pharoah got the same treatment from the Lord. Why? Because it was a good way to introduce who the only real God was to ungodly kings...scare them...bring God on the scene!

Now the court of Pharaoh urgently wants to know: Who is this great man Abram and who is his great God that even our Pharaoh who is supposed to be the son of God (Ra) is deathly afraid of him. And that gave Abram the opportunity to tell the gospel story:

"I Abram am the descendant of the great Adam of Eden, who told of the great God of heaven and His salvation to Methuselah personally, who told to my ancestor Shem the king/priest of Salem the story and he told it to me personally. There is only one God. Your many gods are not gods and are powerless to save. Serve Him alone"

Those many Egyptians who heard this story from Abram and believed "crossed over" from paganism to belief in the one and only true God of all mankind. They were called "Hebrews" by the other Egyptians. Hebrew means "to cross over". That is why Abram is father of the Hebrews.

Then years later a young man is brought out of slavery named Joseph and saves the nation from famine with a prophetic word from the one true God. Everyone is shocked to discover that he is the great-grandson of the famous Abram...the prophet of the one true God. Joseph is made Prime Minister and many convert to become Hebrews. Joseph's father Jacob and his 11 brothers arrive in Egypt to great rejoicing and hun-

dreds of thousands of Egyptians join themselves to the Jacob/Israel clan as was the custom of ancient times...you can be adopted into a new family clan.

The years go by. Joseph and Abram are forgotten and the Egyptian priesthood of many gods and much income that goes with temple institutions rise up in power and declare the one God religion to be anathema and enslave the adherents the "Hebrews" (They did that many years later also to Pharaoh Akhenaton and his son Tutenkhamen who was assassinated when the Egyptian priesthood literally wiped out all possible traces of Akhenaton's reign)....and then God sent a deliverer, Moses who would take the Hebrews to Sinai for a meeting with this one true God.

Now it was at Sinai, when the law was given that Hebrews became Israelites when they accepted the covenant relationship with God. Israel comes from Ish-Ra-El meaning Man Ruled God or a man ruled by God who rules over man by His covenant law. When you accept to be ruled over by God and His Word then you are transformed from Hebrew to Israelite. Just as Jacob was transformed into Israel after His all night wrestling with the angel of the Lord (who in actual fact was Jesus).

And so through the ages the apostolic mission work of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob have been repeated by missions all over the world and in all times. We go to the pagans of the world. We tell the old gospel story with prophetic power and deliverance. They believe. They cross over from unbelief to faith in the God of Abraham. They become Hebrews. They then submit to the discipleship program of God that transforms Hebrews into Israelites...a people ruled by God's Word and faithful to His covenant promises.

And that is why this great world wide movement of God's salvation has never even from its inception been about race but it has always been about grace. Abram believed God and it was counted to him for righteousness...and all others through the ages who have believed God and trusted in His covenant promises have been grafted into the Israel of God the family of Abraham from the first Egyptian converts thousands of years ago to today's Christians!

Shall a nation be born in a day?

But now lets move the story further and from this mystery explained, we can now answer the mystery of Isaiah 66:8, "Shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion travailed she brought forth her children". And this is where we get understanding about prophecy in the Middle East.

Every prophecy book I have read refers the fulfilment of this verse to the day in May 1948 when Israel declared herself a nation once again and was recognized as such soon after by most nations in the world. Evangelicals rejoiced at this apparent miraculous fulfilment to prophecy. But was it really?

The key to understanding who Israel is and more importantly where Israel is will be found in Psalm 132:13-14

"For the Lord has chosen Zion, he has desired it for his habitation. This is my rest forever, here will I dwell for I have desired it.

Israel was called to be the habitation of God on earth. The people among whom and in whom God dwells. This is important: If you can find out where God dwells in the earth, where His manifest presence is in the earth then you have found Israel. Just because people speak Hebrew does not mean they are Hebrews and just because you draw lines on a map and call it "Israel" does not mean it is Israel. The issue is: Where does God dwell, that is where Israel is.

When Israel left Egypt the presence of God was present with them in the form of the glory cloud and fire over their heads. God dwelt among them therefore they were to be holy.

When Israel entered the Promised Land the presence of God was to be manifested in the Holy of Holies in the Tabernacle. The glory flame of God's presence was manifested over the Ark between the Cherubim. This was so awesome that they tied a rope around the High Priest to pull him out in case he died in the fearsome presence of God.

The first place where God established His presence was in Shiloh (Joshua 18:1; Jeremiah 7:12)

In the days of Eli the priesthood corrupted itself and God removed His presence from Shiloh (Psalm 78:60) and moved it to Jerusalem (Psalm 78:67-68). But the nation corrupted itself and God lifted His presence from the Most Holy Place to the hill outside Jerusalem, the Mount of Olives (Ezekiel 11:22-23).

And from the Mount of Olives the glory of the resurrected Jesus ascended to heaven no more to dwell in temples but it returned 10 days later in the Upper Room which was located on Mount Zion and fell on the 120. We Charismatics make a big deal about the sign of speaking in tongues that manifested that day. But we forget about the fire that appeared over their heads. The glory fire of God's presence had returned to earth! But no longer to dwell in temples made by hand but to dwell in His people, the Israel of God. John the Baptist prophesied this when he said I baptize you in water but He, Jesus will baptize you in the Holy Spirit and fire!

That is why on the day of Pentecost when the glory of God came down and filled the disciples, a nation was born in one day fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah. The nation of Israel was reborn on that day. Jesus told the Jews of his day, "Therefore I say unto you, The Kingdom of God shall be taken from you and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof." (Math. 21:43) That nation was formed on the day of Pentecost!

Peter was there and knew a new nation was born that day when he preached and thousands "crossed over", which is why he wrote, "But you are a chosen generation, a royal priest-hood a holy nation..." (I Peter 2;9).

Paul knew what this great sign meant. That is why he said we individually are now the temple of God (1 Cor. 3:15) and we collectively, the Church are His temple (Eph. 2:19-22). That is why we are the Israel of God. He dwells in us and among us. Where two or three of us are gathered in His name there is Jesus in our midst.

As Jacob's 12 sons and the 70 went into Egypt and came out with a nation of millions of "Hebrews", so also Jesus sent His 12 and the 70 to preach the gospel of the Kingdom and hun-

dreds of millions of "Hebrews" or "born-agains" have come out to form a new nations of the Israel of God.

The City Church is the key to new sheep nations...

These new nations that are formed are called by Jesus His "ekklesias". That is a political term for a City State. Athens was an Ekklesia, Sparta was an Ekklesia so was Rome.

Paul knew what an "ekkleasia" was. He wrote to the "church" or Ekklesia of Ephesus, of Collosia, of Thesalonica, of Philipi, ...these were all new nations. These were sheep nations! The were the new nations that God prophesied over Jacob...a multitude of nations will come out of you. These were the "sheep nations" that Jesus said He would separate out of the nations. These are the nations. Churches, ekklesias that are the inheritance of Christ. These are they who He said 'I will build my Church".

Our evangelical prophecy preachers can't see this. They do not know who the Hebrews were, therefore they do not know who Israel is. They want to see a Temple rebuilt in Jerusalem because they can't see the glory cloud has left the Jews and has now settled upon the Israel of God the seed of Abraham all over the world. That is why when judgment comes to the Middle East to all those who would not have Jesus rule over them (the Jews and Arabs), there will be great confusion and consternation especially in the American evangelical church.

Now here is a very important idea:

God has not called us to "win a nation for Christ" as in "Lets win South Africa for Jesus"! That is not going to happen. He has called us to "Grow a nation for His Kingdom". National boundaries are falling away as are notions of "nationalism", race divisions, language, culture etc. People around the world are losing their national and cultural identities. Most corporate people have no national loyalties anymore. They consider themselves world citizens and will move and operate wherever profit is to be made. Same with international labour mobility. You go where the best opportunities are for you and your family.

The New Nation States of the New Israel

The more citizens we add to each city "ekklesia", the more resources we have to do more work...the less resources the enemy has at his disposal. Even if we just start with one family in one city...we grow and grow.

This has created a wonderful opportunity for the Kingdom of God to create new covenant relationships based on new identities, new ties, new goals. Here is the critical idea to understand:

God has given us work to do in this world. You can accomplish more work if you work with other people. The more people you gather around to accomplish goals the bigger your goals can be, the more work you can get done.

In the Kingdom of God there is spiritual work, social work and physical economic work that needs to be done. Every person is called upon to do work in God's Kingdom. Your are responsible before God for the talents He has given you. You are required one day to stand before God and give account for your life. Jesus said, "Father the work you have given me to do I have finished". You need to be able to say that one day before the Lord.

God organizes His people into groupings to do work. He brings man and woman together to do the work of family. But at every progression of God's Kingdom organization there are goals and work that needs to be done. There is work that you can do alone but most work must be done with others. That is where new relationships are formed, new covenants, new ways of doing things, new motivations

That is how you grow a nation. Now here is a very important idea:

The New Nation States of the New Israel

When Jesus chose 70 and sent them to preach the gospel of the Kingdom He knew what He was doing....go unto all the nations, and make disciples of all the 70 nations under demonic power captivity ruled by the "archons" of the world...principalities and powers in the heavenly places.

In each city they go into they are to establish an "ekklesia" a new government of God's rule. The church of Ephesus, of Antioch, of Thesalonica....from there people are to be taken out of the kingdom of darkness and adopted into God's family into His Kingdom of light. Depopulate Rome....re-populate the New Jerusalem!

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God organizes His people into groupings to do work. He brings man and woman together in marriage to do the work of family....raise children.

But the Lord wants men to grow from fathers to patriarchs! Grow an extended family that you care for and leave an inheritance to your next generations.

The Lord wants families to work together or people come together in 'clans" like Apostolic companies that tackle new projects together. Starting businesses or launching projects. In each company there are Prophetic visionaries, teachers who are skill developers, pastors who are excellent administrators....

Clans and groups need to come together to form new virtual cities for the Kingdom of God where the social work of the Levite ministry can be supported of welfare, education, healing, justice and laws....

These larger Kingdom cities need to form larger associations of covenant relationships with other Kingdom cities that can take on large regional projects like power generation, banking, insurance, universities and other great infrastructure works. All under the authority of God's elders and God's government.

But at every progression of God's Kingdom organization there are goals and work that needs to be done. There is work that you can do alone but most work must be done with others. That is where new relationships are formed, new covenants, new ways of doing things, new motivations....

That is how the world's corporations were formed,...people had a vision that there is a need in society and that needs must be met and so they organized capital, skills, information, marketing, labour, and set about gathering people to their vision.

These are the activities in the market place that need to come under the authority and power of the Kingdom of God.

This is the new mission field of the Church....

This is how Jesus described what constitutes "Sheep Nations"....Math 25:34-35:

"Then shall the king say unto them on his right hand (the sheep nations) Come ye blessed of my Father inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me meat; I was thirsty and you gave me drink; I was a stranger and you took me in; naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you visited me; I was in prison and you came to me.

This is a good list of the agenda items for the new nations that need to be formed...provide in the human needs of people...as well as the spiritual needs.
