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
Civilization Collapse: The Sacrifice of the Children

With that as background I saw this chart this last week from America....



Less than 15% of 30 year olds in America are married and have bought a house! And you can repeat that statistic across Europe and Asia and South America and Africa.

That's not just a societal transformation. It's not an economic fluke. It's the visible outcome of an invisible strategy—a Satanic one that extracted everything it could from a three-generation arc and left a generation of young people incapable of stable family formation.

They'll tell you people just choose differently now—that marriage rates fell because of changing values. Yes partly true. But people can't choose what they can't afford. When the economic foundation for family formation disappears, cultural changes follow inevitably. That chart doesn't show us changing values or new priorities. It shows systemic breakdown, disguised for decades as freedom to choose.

It maps the slow evaporation of the social contract. For one generation, adulthood was a starting point. For the next, a struggle. For the latest, a struggle for survival paycheck to paycheck month to month. This wasn't merely economic. It was existential. The foundations of meaning—family, ownership, stability—were quietly downgraded to lifestyle preferences, and then systematically priced out. People without homes are easier to relocate. People without families are easier to isolate. People without rootedness are easier to govern.

And across Asia the demographic crisis spreads.....

East Asia faces an unprecedented demographic transformation that will reshape the region's economic and social foundations within decades. From Seoul to Singapore, fertility rates have collapsed below replacement levels, creating aging societies with shrinking workforces and mounting care demands.

While this crisis spans multiple countries, Japan provides the clearest window into both the challenges ahead, having reached the most advanced stage of demographic decline.

The regional scope is staggering. South Korea's fertility rate has plummeted to 0.72, the world's lowest, while China's has fallen to 1.09 despite abandoning its one-child policy. Taiwan sits at 0.87, and Singapore at 0.97. At this rate China will have 746 million people less than today by the end of the century. A children per woman needs to be 2,1 for replacement of population.

These aren't temporary fluctuations but sustained collapses driven by shared pressures: intense educational competition, high living costs, demanding work cultures and persistent gender inequalities that burden women with disproportionate caregiving responsibilities.

Japan, as the demographic frontrunner, illustrates where this trajectory leads. In 2024, births fell to 686,061—the first time below 700,000 since 1899—while deaths approached 1.6 million, shrinking the population by 900,000 people.

The fertility rate dropped to 1.15, and in Tokyo, it's below 1.0. With seniors comprising 30% of the population and working-age adults only 59%, Japan faces smaller tax bases, strained pensions and regions struggling with aging and decline.

From the Japanese statistics let me explain why this world wide demographic collapse is an unstoppable civilizational death loop that cannot now be stopped. Last year Japan had 1,600,000 deaths but only 686,000 births. Those births need to replace the deaths. Of the births half are women.....343,000. Those women each must produce 5 children just to replace the population lost

in the year they were born. They won't statistically, they will only produce 1 child each. That is 343,000 children of which half will be girls, producing 171,000 births...do you get it? By 2100 Japan ceases to exist as a viable nation. The same with Korea or for that matter most of Europe and most other nations. That includes Muslim nations, Only Africa is growing.

Three fundamental barriers persist throughout East Asia and all other high income nations. High-intensity work cultures directly conflict with family formation, especially for women caught between career demands and caregiving expectations. Marriage-centric approaches to parenthood reduce births when marriage itself becomes delayed or avoided.

Rising costs of housing, education and child-rearing push desired family sizes below replacement levels, particularly in expensive metropolitan areas. These create self-reinforcing cycles visible across the region: fewer young adults produce fewer births, accelerating aging and fiscal pressure, which tightens labor markets and makes family formation even harder.

And now add in around the world wide increase of a culture that promotes homosexual lifestyles, abortion, birth control pills and the delay of marriage into the 30's so that young people can enjoy lifestyles of carefree shopping, travel and consumption.

Now add in time and health destroying addictions of young people deep into drugs, computer games and pornography....and you have a culture that does not lead to responsible loving human relationships that lead to homes, children and stability.

The Scriptures give us a historical narrative of a Satanic priority that requires child sacrifice for the blessings of the gods as in Baal worship or tyrannies like Herod and Pharaoh that demand the killing of babies to stop the purposes of God for His people.

Today there are a multitude of ways to kill the children. The most thorough is just make it a choice or an economic reality that stops the very act of procreation.

Look beyond governments or corporations or economics....and see the Satanic forces of spiritual wickedness in high places that see every baby born as a possible Spirit filled child of God that will crush them with the Word of God and the Sword of the Spirit! And cast them in the hell and abyss they belong.

As It Was In the Days of Noah

We hear much preaching of the "end times" using what Jesus said "as in the days of Noah".

Let me give you an alternate interpretation that gives the Church of the 21st Century a plan of action in a world going into a demographic death spiral.

The Amish of America have this demographic distinction. They double their numbers every generation. And they don't hold evangelistic crusades, or missionaries, or TV shows or megachurches. They have growing families and caring close communities.

Preachers miss the point of the analogy of 'as in the days of Noah". The one that is taken and the one who is left behind has nothing to say about the rapture taking believers out of the world. Read the scripture again. The message of Noah is that the wicked are taken out and the righteous Noah and his family are left behind. That is what our future is.

Our Noah strategy must be this. It is time to build arks where we can place our families and productive assets in to separate our communities from a world civilization that is now going down a demographic doom loop that nations cannot escape.

I will not in this blog go into details of the how strategy. For Noah it was a 120 years of building and preparation for the deluge to come. Warning: This needs to be a generational strategy.

For we the church of the 21st Century we need to see the real signs of the times. Aging populations, not enough children to care for the aged, pay the taxes to for the running of governments and pay the masses of debt left by their parents for the next generations, or have enough workers to continue the maintenance and growth that modern finance capitalism requires to keep consumers buying and spending.

It is time to think, pray, plan Kingdom communities for generational strategies to inherit the earth that the wicked will leave behind as they die out.

And yes Paul did ask a question most Christians don't think much about....1 Cor. 6:3 "Know ye not that we shall judge angels" Yes fallen angels. God promised this in Genesis 3:15.

In our new world we will clean out the earth of these evil toxic malevolent demonic forces and cast them in the abyss to liberate planet earth. So we can build a wonderful safe productive communities as God intended....for the safety and flourishing of our children. Generation by generation.
