Analysis of the Wash. DC, 6th of January Prophetic Disaster

On that day Donald Trump officially lost the presidential election, the Republicans lost the Senate and a mass demonstration called for by the prophetic leadership across America to "Stop the Steal" invaded the Capitol building to stop the Electoral College. It was also the day that the prophetic leaders in the Charismatic movement lost all credibility. It's time for honest analysis by the Church of the Global South...what's going wrong in the American Church?

I was going to wait for this analysis till after the 20th January inauguration of Biden because so many of my fellow Charismatics believe that a last minute miracle is going to get Donald Trump re-elected according to a multitude of prophecies that my analysis would be a waste of time until Biden is actually sitting in the White House. Such is the power of faith.

However the tragic mob invasion of the Capitol building changed my mind. It was obviously over for Donald Trump and all the prophecies. The American public and the world watched aghast at what looked like a violent uprising by a mob of over a hundred thousand people to launch a coup to prevent the Electoral College from legally confirming the Biden victory.

But there is a further tragic background to this. I had been diligently following all the major prophetic voices in the American church both from before the Nov. 3 election and afterwards. I was waiting to see who would in the week after the election make a public apology to the Church "Sorry folks I got it wrong, this was not a word from the Lord". None came.

What happened next over the last two months was tragic. Everyone doubled down on the prophecies. Donald Trump did not actually lose; the election was stolen but the Lord allowed this to expose the corruption....now an even greater miracle was going to happen. The miracle of the Supreme Court is going to overturn the election. Proof? Trump miraculously got 3 solid conservatives onto the court to assure 5-4 victory. Then came the mass appeals for money for court cases etc.

None of this worked. No miracle court cases. Then came the next appeal. Mike Pence and the congressional Republicans are going to eliminate the electors from 4 states and deny Biden the 270 votes he needed. But to do that we need massive prayer and intercession across the nation and we need a million Christians in Washington DC on 6th January to show the Republicans in Congress that the people are with them....the great rally was called "Stop the Steal".

Now here comes the tragic part. Everyone knows who the more than 100,000 people were who showed up at the 'Stop the Steal' rally. It was Donald Trump's base, the evangelical Christians. Everyone also knows who rallied them to get there in the midst of winter. Everyone also knows what they were trying to do there....to stop the legal process of a Biden election certification. And they knew what the plan of action was....Republican lawmakers on the inside slowing down the process with objections and debate and stop the whole election certification and an enormous mob on the outside threatening action.

In any other country in the world in any other national election this scenario would be obvious....an insurrection to effect a coup to stop a legal process of an election. In China and Russia the media gloated about "American democracy". In Europe and other parts of the world there was universal condemnation. Across the American media and throughout the nation the cry went out...."But this is not America!".

If the American evangelical Charismatic movement does not think there are going to be severe consequences of public persecution then they are in for a major surprise. At the moment the FBI and the media are picking out certain photos of individuals for prosecution. But this is just the beginning. They are eventually going to come for the background organizers, who motivated so many people to come, what was the purpose? The result is going to be "the Charismatic evangelical movement organized this mob turnout, the purpose....to overturn and throw out a legally elected president of the United States." You will hear the words "treason" and "sedition" and "insurrection" in the days ahead. (Much like you heard "Russian collusion" after the 2016 election and Democrats trying to throw out a duly elected Pres. Trump).

So when all the dust is settled what is the political landscape in America? When Donald Trump was elected 4 years ago the Republicans controlled the Presidency, the Senate and the Congress. In control of all the positions of power in government what did they do with that? 4 years later they have lost the Presidency, the Senate and the Congress.

In making an analysis of this disaster let me tell you where I am coming from:

God is sovereign over all the earth and creation:

Psalms 22:28 ***"For the kingdom is the Lord's and he is governor among the nations".***
Daniel 4: 17 ***"...to the intent that the living may know that the most high rules in the kingdom of men and gives it to whomsoever he will and sets up over it the basest of men"***

I reject any and all arguments defending the failure of the prophets and their prophecies that would say....God wanted Donald Trump to be re-elected but the election was stolen, or if only the Christians had prayed more or any other such excuse.

If the purpose of God is expressed in "Thus sayeth the Lord Donald Trump will be re-elected President" then that is what will happen. Nothing can stop the plans and the purposes of God. If it is written in the books of heaven and God knows the end from the beginning then that is what is going to be. If God wants to put Joe Biden in the

Oval Office on 20th January then that is what is going to happen....regardless of whether you think him to be "the basest of men".

So my first conclusion is that there was at no times a failure of the Word of God or the inability of God to perform His intentions in the earth.

The obvious failure was that none of these prophecies were from the Lord and the prophets spoke from their own spirits and not from God's Spirit. Does that make spiritual sense to you?

Assuming the above is true, then there flows from that some severe analysis. Here again let me tell you my bias. I have been a life long Pentecostal Christian with the wonderful privilege of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit at age 12 in an Assembly of God youth camp in America. I have spent my life and energy in the Charismatic movement (although being called to the business world) because I believe this is the mainstream of what the Lord is doing in the earth. Although there are many different expressions of the Church on the earth, the only expression of the Church that is growing every year is the Charismatic evangelical movement. All other churches are declining in numbers every year. The integrity of this movement is critical!

Although a South African and placed by the Lord to be active in the Church in South Africa I look upon the American Charismatic church the same way that Paul and the NT church looked to the Jerusalem Church.....the Mother Church. It was from America that the great missionaries and apostles and prophets and evangelists went into all the world to plant new churches everywhere. (and British missionaries!)

So what happens in America affects all of us around the world. Our distinction as Charismatics is our belief in the restoration of the gifts of the Spirit and the restoration of the 5-fold ministry to the Church. We believe in prophecy and we believe in the office of prophet. So if the gift of prophecy and the office of prophet is brought into disrepute and mocked at by the world then it hurts all of us.

So I have been wrestling with this a long time. I am in search of the message of the hour for my nation South Africa as I am sure the American church is seeking for themselves God's word for America. So by the grace of world internet and technology I can follow many of the leading prophetic ministries for a long time. I have even been following every week for over a year the QAnon movement with great interest.

With that as background, here is my analysis of what I believe the failure of the prophetic movement in America originates from.

I go back to my example of Paul and the Jerusalem church. Early in his contact with the leaders of the Jerusalem church Paul relates the problem he had with them in his letter to the Galatians. He made sure that he had the basics of the gospel right by telling them what he received by revelation from the Lord and not from men. They assured him he is ok.

But his faith in Christ was not the problem. He discovered that he had a totally different approach to the whole issue of the manifestation of the Kingdom of God.

When they departed from one another the leaders of the Jerusalem church in effect told him this:

Gal. 2:9: *Brother Paul we extend to you the right hand of fellowship. However we only feel led to preach to the "circumcision" i.e. to the Jews, but you must feel free to go preach to the Gentiles.*

Paul had no intention of course to keep himself from just preaching to Gentiles, everywhere he went he preached to Jews and Gentiles. But here was a strange phenomenon. Even though Jesus had commanded His apostles to go into all the world and make disciples of all nations.....somehow the leaders of the Jerusalem church had become obsessed with only one mission and one nation...the Jews. Paul can go and preach to the nations, that is fine, but as for the Jerusalem church....we are only going to preach to our fellow Jews.

The consequence for this disobedience of the Jerusalem church is that instead of preaching the Kingdom of God...they were captured by their Jewish culture and Jewish nationalism. So much so that Paul tells us that he had to upbraid Peter in Antioch who when he heard that people from Jerusalem were coming he quickly separated himself from Gentile believers and would only eat with Jews. And when Paul went to Jerusalem again the church there had so backslidden into Jewish cultural influence that the church leaders demanded Paul go to the Temple with a sacrifice and go through a rite of purification because he was so polluted with all his contacts with Gentiles....that was their doctrine of Sanctification.

What does this have to do with Donald Trump and the American evangelical church?

Well what has become very obvious is that the evangelical church in America has been captured by Donald Trump and the Republican party with their agenda of "Make America Great Again and Make Israel Great Again". The prophetic plan for restoring America's greatness was though a Trump presidency and the vehicle would be the Republican party. The strategies would include bombing all Israel's enemies, restoring the God given Constitution and honoring the intentions of the founding fathers of America (Washington, Madison, Jefferson et al) through conservative judges. This was the preaching strategy of the evangelical charismatic church!

The deception is not obvious to any American charismatic I have ever spoken to which is:

- The real founders of America were the Puritans of whom more than 60,000 arrived to settle the colonies between 1620-1680....the real Godly leaders were men like Gov. Bradford the governor of the Massachusetts Commonwealth whose express articles of government as were all the other colonies was that the purpose of America was to establish the Kingdom of God on the continent, serve the Lord Jesus and follow the Bible as their guide to life.
- the rebellion of 1776 by Washington and the other rebels was to overthrow the Godly purpose of America and replace it with a Masonic constitution where the American purpose now became "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness" in a secular humanist state. Their gods were not the Lord of scripture but Isis/Columba that ancient whore of Babylon also known as Ishtar consort to Baal and from whom Washington District of Columbia is dedicated as her throne.

In short, the evangelical charismatic church in America has been captured by cultural nationalism to advance the interests of the nation state and its rulers and have lost the vision of the Kingdom of God is our first and only priority to make great!

Which brings me to my second disagreement with them:

Everyone prays 2 Chron 7:14. "If my people....." Lord heal our land. But scripture clearly states in the book of Revelation who the vehicle is to heal the land. Read Rev. 21&22. The vehicle is the New Jerusalem...from which flows a river of life and fruit and leaves for the healing of the nations.

But the American church does not believe this. The New Jerusalem is for a long time in the future after the Millennium. It is not for now. What obsesses them now is not the New Jerusalem but the Old Jerusalem. Moving the American embassy to Jerusalem will help to heal America. Because the key to the Kingdom of God on earth is Israel and the Jews. The blessing of earthly Jerusalem is therefore the key to God's blessing for America.

So for the prophetic charismatic movement in America when they pray :Lord heal our land....they saw the obvious road ahead:

God's answer was Donald Trump and the Republican Party will restore our God given Masonic Constitution and restore the vision of our Founding Fathers Washington and Madison and their dream of a secular humanist state. And of course if we bless Bibi Netanyahu and Israel which Donald Trump promised to do then obviously the Lord will bless America.

And what has been God's response to this strategic vision of the American church? Covid-19 has destroyed the American economy (or atleast the government response has destroyed the economy) and Donald Trump has destroyed the Republican Party. My prediction? There will never again be a Republican Party president.

My further prediction? Joe Biden and Kamala Harris will give America what it really wants: A socialist government that promises to take care of you from cradle to grave, free education, free healthcare, universal basic income, open borders, defund the police.

The coming of the Secular Fundamentalist state has arrived in America.

In the midst of this in the coming years the church will find again the gospel of the Kingdom of God. It will discover that the Church is the New Jerusalem which will rise to heal the nation. Why? Because the secular fundamentalist socialist state of America will collapse with the American dollar unable to pay for its endless expenditures and the only alternative left is the Church of Jesus Christ rising in every county of America as the healer of the nations.

Watch for the new prophetic and apostolic leadership that is coming that will really preach the gospel of the Kingdom with a new level of power and anointing.
